



## William E. Handy

William E. Handy of Doncaster Road, Easton died on Friday, January 21, 2005 at William Hill Manor after a long illness. He was 76.

Born in Duluth, MN on March 10, 1928 he was the son of Eve and E. E. Handy.

Mr. Handy was raised in Fairfield, CT where his family's association with the Remington Arms Company began. A lifelong skeet enthusiast, Mr. Handy broke 98 out of 100 targets to become the 1941 title holder of the National North American Skeet Shooting Association. He was a 1946 graduate of the Choate School in Wallingford, CT and a 1950 graduate of the University of Pennsylvania's Wharton School of Finance. That same year, Mr. Handy graduated from Officer Candidate School and entered the U.S. Army, going on to serve during the Korean War.

In 1952, Mr. Handy married the former Susan Stanley of Trumbull, CT. They moved to Talbot County in 1960. Mr. Handy was a former member of the Chesapeake Bay Yacht Club and the Tred Avon Yacht Club. Mrs. Handy died on June 15, 1990.

He is survived by a son, William Handy of Easton; two daughters, Susan H. duPont also of Easton and Sara H. Finney of Baltimore and six grandchildren.

Services will be private. A reception will be held on Wednesday, January 26, 2005 at the Chesapeake Bay Yacht Club on North Washington Street in Easton, MD from 5 – 7 p.m.
