William E. "Bill" Hyland Sr. of Rock Hall passed away Friday, April 30, 2010 at Chester River Hospital Center from complications of a fall. He was 68.

Raised in Rock Hall he was born August 10, 1941 the son of the late, Walter "Bootie" Hyland and Mildred "Millie" Hyland Hawthorne. He graduated from Rock Hall High School Class of 1960. He served in the U. S. Coast Guard and was proud to serve his country. Bill worked many years for Baltimore Business Forms and then went on to manage PDQ Business Forms in New York. He later returned to Chestertown to be the office manager of Wisco Envelope Company, then retiring due to ill health.

Bill played and loved sports, he particularly enjoyed golf and watching all sports on TV. He was a member of Sgt. Preston Ashley American Legion, past Commander, Chestertown Elks #2474, past exulted ruler and former member of Chester River Yacht and Country Club. He was a faithful member of Rock Hall Church of God. Bill's last residence was in the Rock Hall Senior Apartments where he met many friends among them a special friend and caring person, Nancy Thomas.
