William Edward Comegys, Jr. of Chester, MD died Monday, September 27, 2010, due to injuries in a motor vehicle accident. He was 59.

Born July 31, 1951 in Baltimore, MD, he was the son of Mary Ethel Whaley-Comegys and the late, William E. Comegys, Sr. Billy grew up in Queenstown and by the age of 14 he received his Eagle Scout. He graduated from Queen Anne's County High School, Class of 1969 and later attended Chesapeake College where he received his Associates Degree. He met and married the love of his life, Kathy Horney, on August 14, 1971. In 1975, they purchased Ebb Tide restaurant in Grasonville, which would move to Chester until 1992, when they would close the restaurant and establish Ebb Tide Catering and Tent Rentals, until 2004 when stopped catering and focused just on tent rentals.

He was an active member with the Queenstown Lions Club, Queen Anne's County Chamber of Commerce, Kent Island Yacht Club, and Ducks Unlimited. He enjoyed hunting, fishing, crabbing, carving and painting decoys, and he especially enjoyed vacationing in Cancun.

Billy is survived by his loving wife, Kathy Comegys, of Chester, MD; his mother, Mary Ethel Whaley-Comegys of Bridgeville, DE; two daughters, Cara L. Phillips and her husband, Richard, of Frederick, MD and Kristin Schindler

and her husband, Christopher, of Easton, MD; his son, William "Willie" Edward Comegys, III and his wife, Heather of Ridgley, MD; a brother, James Comegys of Bridgeville, DE; a sister, Deborah Holland of Bridgeville, DE and four grandchildren, Colin and Reagan Phillips, Addison Schindler, and Baby C on the way.

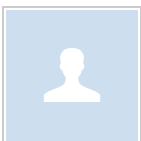

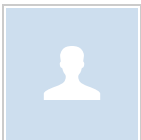
