



## William Emory Lane

September 1, 1921 - March 28, 2011

William Emory Lane of Stevensville, died on Monday March 28, 2011 at his home surrounded by his loving family. He was 89.

Born September 1, 1921 in Stevensville, MD., William was the son of the late William Stanley and Elizabeth Palmer-Lane. He grew up in Stevensville and graduated from Stevensville High School, Class of 1939 and then attended University of Maryland. On February 20, 1943 he married Muriel Virginia O'Donnell of Grasonville, MD. Mr. Lane farmed Indian Spring Plantation until he retired in the early 1980's. William was a member of the Kent Island United Methodist Church where he served on the committee to build the church. He was a past president of AARP in Stevensville, MD.
