William Franklin "Bill" Gannon died at his home in Easton, MD on Sunday, April 24, 2005. He was 78.

Born, July 22, 1926 in Centreville, MD, he was the son of the late William C. and Edna Mae Wilson Gannon. After attending St. Michaels High School, he served in the United States Navy from 1944 to 1946. He spent most of his working life as an auto body repair mechanic for Bramble's Body Shop. He also worked for many years as a bartender at The Tidewater Inn, the Aspen Institute, and Harbourtowne Golf Resort.

He was a member of American Legion Post #70 where he was a past Commander and a founding member of the Talbot Color Guard and Talbot Twirlers.
