William F. Maxwell of Chester died on Monday, March 25, 2002 at John's Hopkins Hospital in Baltimore. He was 74.

Born on October 18, 1927 in Washington, D.C. he was the son of the late Orrie G. and Mary Nasella Maxwell. At the age of 17, he enlisted in the U.S. Army as a paratrooper, serving during WWII and the Korean Conflict. During WWII, he served in Germany assisting members of concentration camps getting back to their homeland. On April 11, 1958 he married the former Joan Schwab, and they began their home together in Bladensburg, Maryland. They moved to Chester in 1989. Mr. Maxwell worked for C.A.E. as a carpenter until his retirement in 1993. He loved crabbing and the Eastern Shore.

In addition to his wife, he is survived by a daughter, Sandra Mills of Chester; three brothers, Richard Maxwell of Wheatland, CA, John "Jackie" Maxwell of Chester and Paul "Butch" Maxwell of Chester; a sister, Mary Margaret Turner of Chester; and a granddaughter, Brittani Mills of Chester. He was predeceased by a brother, Essel Maxwell.
