William Henry Gernert of Grasonville, MD. died of heart failure November 9, 1999 at the University Hospital in Baltimore, MD. He was 55.

Born on January 19, 1944 in Grasonville, MD he was the son of the late Christian and Lillian Collins Gernert. He was a graduate of Stevensville High School Class of 1962. He worked in the construction industry prior to working for the Maryland Transportation Authority.
