William “Bill” MacGill MacHale of Chestertown, MD died on Wednesday, October 28, 2009 at the Corsica Hills Nursing Home, Centreville, MD. He was 85.

Born April 3, 1924 in Winchester, VA, he was the son of the late, John Martin and Margaretta Kremer MacHale. He grew up in Easton, MD and was a graduate of Easton High School, Class of 1941. He enlisted in the U.S. Navy and served 3 ½ years during World War II and received an Honorable Discharge in 1945. He received his Law Degree from Georgetown University, Washington, DC and had several practices in Montgomery County. He married the former, Patricia Archer Hill of Washington, DC.

While living in Chestertown, MD he retired from practice in 1995.

Bill lived for family, golf and crabs. He was a member of the Chestertown Lions Club, as well as a loyal member of the Republican party. Bill was a devoted fan of the Washington Redskins.
