William Paige Johnson died on Tuesday, November 10, 2009 at the Delaware Veterans Home in Milford, DE at the age of 91.

He was born in Chester, Maryland on October 6, 1918 to the late, Grover Cleveland Johnson and the late, Addie Tarbutton Johnson, he resided until 1999 on Kent Island. He married Mary Catherine Bryan on March 22, 1946. Mr. Johnson was a life-long waterman until he retired in 1987. He also worked as a carpenter and painter and made Christmas decorations all year as a hobby

Paige served in the U.S. Army from September 1941 to November 1945 in WWII. He was assigned to the 364th Field Artillery Battalion in Europe. Paige was a life-long member of the Kent Island United Methodist Church where he was a trustee when the church was built. He was also a life member of the VFW.
