William R. "Newt" Kirby of Centreville, formerly of Annapolis, MD died at his home on Monday, March 4, 2002. He was 62.

Born in Annapolis, MD on September 5, 1939, he was the son of Mildred D. Taylor of Centreville and the late Warren Russell Kirby. He attended the Annapolis High School and was drafted into the U.S. Army and served from March 4, 1963 until his discharge on February 28, 1969. He served in Germany during his tour of duty and following his release from active duty he returned to Annapolis where he began working at Rookies Food Store as a meat cutter. He remained there until becoming disabled and then moved to Centreville in 1986.

Prior to his military service he had been very active in the Annapolis Volunteer Fire Company.

He had participated and was active in the Crossroads Community, both in Centreville and Annapolis.

In addition to his mother, Mr. Kirby is survived by a brother, Robert G. Kirby of Westover, MD; a sister, Jane E. Kjeldsen of Glen Burnie; two nieces, Debra Kirby and Deborah Mathes; two nephews, Eddie Mathes and Carl Kirby, Jr. He was pre-deceased by a brother, Carl F. Kirby, Sr. in 1977.

Funeral services will be held on Friday, March 8, 2002 at the Fellows, Helfenbein & Newnam Funeral Home, Centreville at 11:00 AM. Friends and family may call at the funeral home on Thursday evening from 7 – 9 PM.

Burial will be at the Maryland Veteran Cemetery, Crownsville, MD.
