William Raymond Marshall, Jr. of Easton, MD died on Sunday, February 27, 2005 at William Hill Manor, Easton. He was 83.

Born March 19, 1921 in St. Michaels, MD, he was the son of the late William Raymond, Sr. and Florence Amanda Tarbuton Marshall. His family moved to Princess Anne when his father took the position as Vice-President of Cannon Electric, Inc. After his father's death in 1933, the family returned to St. Michaels. After being educated in Somerset and Talbot Counties, he worked for his uncle, Otto Blankenhorn, in Arlington, VA for a short time before entering the U.S. Army in 1942. He served with the 5th Army-804th Tank Destroyer Battalion-HQ Company in North Africa and Italy. After his release from active duty he worked for Forney's Electric before joining the IBEW, working on large construction jobs until his retirement.

His wife the former Edith M. Eaton, whom he married July 1, 1955, died February 1, 2001.

A member of the International Brotherhood of Electrical Workers Local 24, he was also a member of the American Legion and since December 2001, he enjoyed attending Delmarva Daybreak.

Mr. Marshall is survived by two children, William Raymond Marshall, III and

his wife Robyn of Easton, and Lynda L. Marshall of Harmony; two sisters, Betty M. Seymour and Florence M. George; and a brother, Charles P. Marshall all of Easton; two grandchildren, Cherie M. Wroten and her husband Dwayne, and William Raymond Marshall, IV and his wife Nancy; two great-grandchildren, K. Brandon Gowe and Brennen Marshall Wroten; and his first wife, Ada L. Gurney. He was predeceased by three sisters, Frances M. Covey, Elsie M. Jones and Esther M. Jones.
