William Robert (Bob) Miller died on November 6, 2006, in Easton, Maryland. He was 92.

Born in Baltimore, Maryland, in 1913, Bob was the son of the late Elmer and Eva Miller. He graduated in 1932 from City College High School in Baltimore, where he played lacrosse, and graduated in 1936 from St. Johns College in Annapolis. After college, he served in the U.S. Coast Guard during World War II, from 1942-1945. He was given Atlantic Coast duty and achieved the rank of Lieutenant, senior grade.

After the Coast Guard, Bob worked for a time for Diebold in the banks and safe division and then was the Director of the American Council on Alcoholism. At St. Johns, he was a member of the Sigma Alpha Epsilon fraternity; in Baltimore he was a member and past President of The Quarterback Club of the Baltimore Colts; the Toastmaster Club; and in Alcoholics Anonymous—at the time of his death he was sober for 56 years, one of the longest active recoveries in the state of Maryland.

Bob is survived by his wife of 67 years, Shirley Morton Miller of Easton; his daughter Robin Miller Valliant and her husband Robert of Oxford; two grandchildren, Susan Valliant Hutchison and her husband Chad, and Michael Robert Valliant and his wife Robin, all of Easton; and three great

grandchildren, Anna Louise Valliant, Ava Elaine Valliant, and Julian Valliant Hutchison.

Bob and Shirley built a house in Towson, Maryland in 1940 and lived there for 62 years before moving to Londonderry in Easton. They held season tickets for the Baltimore Colts for every year the franchise was in Baltimore and Bob attended every home game The Baltimore Colts ever played.
