William R. "Bill" Davis of Easton, died at the Memorial Hospital Easton, on Saturday, September 8, 2001. He was 68.

Born on September 7, 1933 at the family home in Cordova he was the son of Lonnie Walter and Lula Voshell-Davis. His father died when he was 10 years old leaving his mother to care for him. In 1953 he graduated from Cordova High School, then in 1955 he joined the U.S. Navy where he served honorably from 1955 until his discharge in 1957. On October 1, 1960 he married Marian Sump at St. Pauls Lutheran Church in Cordova. Together they shared 40 years of marriage and raised three sons. He began his working career at Nehi Bottling and later worked for Bayshore Foods and finally at Elliott Equipment and Hardware, where he remained until his retirement in 1995.

Bill was active in the community and a member of the Tuckahoe Steam and Gas Association, the Easton Moose Lodge #1520 and a charter member of the Tri-County Ruritan Club. He also enjoyed working "Bills Kitchen" with his friends in the Saddle Friends Trail Club. He remained an active member of St. Pauls Lutheran Church in Cordova.

In addition to his wife, Bill is survived by three sons and their wives; Donald W. Davis and his wife Kathleen, Keith W. Davis and his wife Ronnie, and Brian A. Davis and his wife Deborah all of Easton. Pop-Pop enjoyed spending time

with and spoiling his grandchildren; K. Alan Davis, Brad Davis, Colleen A.M. Davis, Gareth B. Davis and Daniel E. Davis. He is also survived by a brother; Norman L. Davis Sr. of Easton, and a sister; F. Grace Elben of Cordova. In addition to his parents he was preceded in death by a daughter-in-law Marie Haymaker Davis.
