William Russell Maule, Jr. of Millington, MD died on March 9, 2011 at the Hospice Center in Centreville, MD. He was 78.

He was born in Sudlersville, Maryland on August 5, 1932 the son of the late, William Russell Sr. and Pauline Thompson Maule.
