William Stewart Baldwin of Chestertown, Maryland died April 30, 2007 in Chestertown Nursing and Rehabilitation. He was 85.

Born on February 27, 1922 in Chestertown, Maryland, he was the son of the late, George Walker and Esther Elizabeth Hartman Baldwin. Mr. Baldwin was a 1939 graduate of Chestertown High School and attended Washington College. He served in the U.S. Marine Corps during World War II, volunteering the day after Pearl Harbor. He saw action in the South Pacific Theater. Mr. Baldwin was honorably discharged in 1945. After returning he went to work as a district manager with Babson Company for a time before returning to Chestertown to work for Baldwin Electrical Company.

In the past fifty years, he served on the Boards of First United Methodist Church and Magnolia Hall and as Life Member, Past President and Board of Director of the Chestertown Volunteer Fire Company. On April 13, 1990, he was inducted into The Kent and Queen Anne's Fire and Rescue Association Hall of Fame. Mr. Baldwin was also a Life Member of the Frank Jarman America Legion Post 36.

Mr. Baldwin is survived by his three children, William S. Baldwin, Jr. and his wife, Susan of Kennedyville, Maryland, Ellen Miekle and her husband, Allan of Easton, Maryland, and David Baldwin of Chestertown, Maryland; five

grandchildren, Monica Clark of Greensboro, North Carolina, Christopher Miekle of Cary, North Carolina, Jason Miekle of Columbia, Maryland, Julie Miekle of Easton, Maryland, and Charlie Athey of Chestertown, Maryland; one sister, Elizabeth Booth of Stow, Ohio; three brothers, George Baldwin of Marathon, Florida, Allen Baldwin of Chestertown, Maryland and Hugh Baldwin of Chestertown, Maryland; and a dear friend and companion, Doris Semans.

Funeral services will be held Friday, May 4, 2007 at 10 a.m. at First United Methodist Church, Chestertown, Maryland. Family and friends may call Thursday, May 3rd from 6-8 p.m. at Fellows, Helfenbein and Newnam Funeral Home, 130 Speer Road, Chestertown, Maryland.
