July 17, 1993 - October 5, 2011

William Troy “T” Wilkins, Jr. of Queen Anne, MD died at his home on Wednesday, October 5, 2011. He was 18.

Born July 17, 1993 in Easton, MD, he was the son of William Troy Wilkins and Christina Stevens Wilkins. He grew up in Grasonville and later graduated from Queen Anne’s County High School, Class of 2011.

He was a baritone sax player and assistant drum major his Junior Year and drum major his Senior Year in the Marching Band and a member of the Jazz Band, the Concert Band Pit Orchestra, he achieved 1st Place Drum Major Group 1, Chapter 9 Championship 2010. He received the President’s Award for Educational Excellence, Outstanding Academic Excellence Award in 2011, the Queen Anne’s County High School Maryland Distinguished Scholar in 2011 and the Semper Fidelis Award for Musical Excellence in May 2011.

He loved his family, his pet dog “Jazmin”, playing video games with his brother and was

a computer genius. He was a freshman Pre-Med Student at McDaniel College in Westminster, MD. He recently became a member of the Queenstown Volunteer Fire Company, Queenstown, MD. He worked at Old Navy at Prime Outlets, Queenstown, MD.

In addition to his parents, "T" is survived by a brother, Nolan Brady Wilkins of Queen Anne; maternal grandmother, Linda Stevens of Queenstown; paternal grandparents, Barbara and Billy Wilkins of Ridgely; paternal great grandmother, Pearl Collier of Grasonville; uncle, Bobby Stevens and his wife, Dawn of Centreville; aunt Wendi Rhodes and her husband, Mike of Greensboro and cousins, Whitney Stevens, Krystyna Corkell, Kaitlyn and Michelle Rhodes. He was predeceased by his maternal grandfather, Billy Stevens in 1992.

Funeral services will be held at the Fellows, Helfenbein and Newnam Funeral Home, P. A., Centreville, MD on Tuesday, October 11, 2011 at 11:00 AM where friends may call on Monday from 2 – 4 pm and 6 – 8 pm.

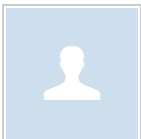
