William Warren Coursey of Chester, MD died at the Memorial Hospital, Easton on Friday, May 9, 2003. He was 79.

Born December 9, 1923 in Chester, MD, he was the son of the late John R. and Annie Tolson Coursey. He attended Queen Anne's County Schools and as a young man worked in his father's ice and oyster business. During World War II he served in the U.S. Army in action E.T.O in Normandy, Northern France, Rhineland. Following his release from active duty in 1945 he went to work for the State of Maryland with the Dept. of Transportation and Toll Facilities where he remained until his retirement in 1976 after 33 years of service.

He was a member of the Prospect Bay Country Club, the Blue Heron Mens League, the MISGA, the American Legion Post 278, and a charter member of V.F.W. Post #7464.

Mr. Coursey is survived by his wife, the former Phyllis Colleen Pierson whom he married

February 20, 1947; a son, Richard "Dickie" Coursey and his wife, Norma of Centreville; a daughter, Phyllis Sherbert and her husband, Fred of Queenstown; a sister, Melva Ewing of Centreville; a brother, John L. Coursey of Queenstown, MD; three grandchildren, Heather Tinelli and Deny Coursey,

both of Centreville and Chad Stringer of Stevensville; three great grandchildren, Chad Stringer, Jr. of Easton, Rachel Tinelli and Sarah Tinelli, both of Centreville; a step granddaughter, Lisa Gallow and her husband Tim of Chester and a step great grandchild, Timothy Michael "T.J." Gallow of Chester. He was pre-deceased by a brother, James S. Coursey.
