



## Willie D. Moll

Willie D Moll, of Oaklands, Easton, MD, died at the Stella Maris Hospice, Baltimore, on May 14, 2017. She was 96.

Born in Utopia, TX, on February 28, 1921, she was the third child of the Reverend William Donathan, Williamson and Billia Cara Hillis, born after her brother Don and sister Bernice. After graduating from Mathis High School, she attended the Education College at Texas State University in San Antonio, graduating in 1941. Willie D taught history and in 1942 doubled as an administrative secretary at Kelley Field in San Antonio.

At Kelley Field, she met a handsome young First Lieutenant, Richard R. Moll. Dick, who was preparing to fly his B-17 and crew to Framlingham England, for 25 missions over Germany. Upon Captain Dick's return, he and Willie D were married in August of 1945. After his discharge, Captain Moll started a 37-year career with United Air Lines.

Willie D became a mother and homemaker, with the births of Roberta, in 1947, and Robert in 1950. She lived in Queens and Levittown NY, Ramsey NJ; and finally, Easton, MD, from 1971 to 2017.

Willie D was an excellent cook and entertainer, both on land and at sea, on Dick and her Grand Banks trawler. She was an avid reader, swimmer, and

bridge player. She and Alice Niley were a “duo to be feared”, at the Talbot Country Club. She volunteered with Talbot Hospice, and was a member of the United Methodist Church in Easton.

Willie D led a long, rewarding life and was loved by all who were lucky enough to be her family and friends. She is survived by her children, Roberta, and Robert, her daughter-in-law, Crystal Moll, and numerous nieces and nephews.
