Willis Archie Ross of Easton died peacefully at Talbot Hospice House on December 27, 2012, after a short illness. He was 93 years old. He was born in Prentiss, Alabama on December 14, 1919 to the late William Edgar Ross and Mary Petterson Ross.

He graduated from Greensboro High School and traveled north to Baltimore in 1940 and became employed at Glenn L. Martin building WWII Aircraft. He met and eventually married Marie Lillian Pierson, the girl across the street. They were married 66 years. Mr. Ross worked at and retired from Bethlehem Steel. He and Marie enjoyed camping across the country and traveling annually to Myrtle Beach. They relocated from Baltimore to Easton in 1989 and lived in Hyde Park.

He is survived by his wife, Marie; his daughter, Cindy Reese and her husband, Tom, of Kingsville, MD. He was predeceased by his sisters, Dorothy Harrow and Jewell Murphy; and his brother, Harrell Ross.
