Willis D. Moyer died at his home in St. Michaels, MD on Wednesday, November 23, 2005. He was 81.

Born May 23, 1924 in Lancaster, PA, he was the son of the late B. Willis and Cassandra Durgin Moyer. After graduating from Franklin and Marshall Academy, he received his BA degree in Business Administration from Franklin and Marshall College in Lancaster, PA, where he was a member of the Sigma Pi Fraternity. He received his honorable discharge as 2nd Lt. of the Army Air Force in 1944, after serving as a flight engineer and pilot during World War II. He retired after 25 years with the Union Camp Paper Corporation and then became an independent sales representative until 1995.

A member of Christ Episcopal Church in St. Michaels, he was also a member of Harbourtowne Country Club and the Chesapeake Bay Maritime Museum in St. Michaels. He loved woodworking, boating, fishing and golfing.

Mr. Moyer is survived by his wife, the former, Lois Horning, whom he married on November 27, 1946; three children, Sandra M. Kunkel and her husband Eric of Sebastian, FL, Barbara M. Kennedy and her husband Leo of West Chester, PA, and Willis D. Moyer, Jr. and his wife Heather of Malvern, PA; eight grandchildren; and five great-grandchildren.

A memorial service will be held on Friday, December 2, 2005 at 11:00 AM at Christ Church, St. Michaels.

Burial will be at Greenwood Cemetery, Lancaster, PA.
