



Willis Francis Dagenais II

Elder Willis Francis Dagenais II of Hurlock passed away on Thursday January 5, 2006 surrounded by family at Baltimore Veterans Medical Center. He was 65.

Born May 9, 1940, in Baltimore, MD, he was the son of the late Willis F. Dagenais and Minnie Davis Dagenais. Raised in Rock Hall he developed a love for the water he would carry throughout his life. After graduating from Rock Hall High School, he enlisted in the U.S. Navy. Following his release from active duty he returned to the community he loved and began working on the water. It was later in his life that he found his Lord and savior Jesus Christ and a desire to dedicate his life to the Lord's work and received his Masters in Divinity. He continued with a life commitment to the ministry with the Seventh Day Adventist Church. During his ministry he and his family moved to various places including West Virginia, Iowa and Missouri until the mid 1980's when he returned to Maryland. He served a number of churches in the Maryland, Delaware area. At the time of his death he was the pastor of the Cambridge Seventh Day Adventist Church.

Elder Dagenais believed in community involvement, he served as Chaplin for various Fire Departments during his ministry; in addition he was involved with a number of civic groups.

He is survived by his beloved wife Patricia Dagenais whom he married on December 12, 1971; three daughters, Barbara Kemp of West Monroe, LA, Brenda Faulkner-Alexander of Royal Oak, MD and Jeannette Shalaby of Frederick, MD; two brothers, Henry Dagenais of Columbia, MD, and Lester Dagenais of Rock Hall, MD; one sister, Linda George of Worton, MD; three grandchildren, Rickey Kemp, Cissy Kemp and Melissa Faulkner; and many nieces and nephews.

A service of remembrance will be held at the Preston Volunteer Fire Dept. on Sunday, January 15, 2006 at 1:00PM.
