



## Wilma Lee Phoebus

January 8, 1955 - August 2, 2022

Wilma Lee Phoebus “Tee Tee” of Grasonville, MD, died on August 2, 2022, at home with family by her side. She was 67 years old.

Born on January 8, 1955, in Somerset, PA, she was the daughter of the late William Franklin, Sr., and Emily Maye Shaulis.

When the Shaulis family moved into the Pines on the Severn in 1963, Wilma became a natural born swimmer and diver, competing in the community swim and diving teams and earning many trophies and ribbons.

Wilma graduated from Severna Park High School in 1971. After high school, she qualified and was placed directly in the FBI office in Washington, DC. (To this day we don't know what her job actually was.) After leaving the FBI, Wilma went to work for the U.S Naval Academy in the Administrative-Operations office that oversaw all the operations/functions of “Dalhgren Hall.”

In 1990, Wilma married the love of her life Frederick “Fred” Phoebus and lived in Brandywine, MD, later opening Phoebus Electric Company until his sudden death in August 2006. After the death of her husband Wilma moved to Grasonville, MD, retiring from the U.S. Naval Academy in 2014.

Wilma enjoyed spending time with her companion, Harley, that she had since he was a pup, and enjoyed gardening, cross stitching, keeping her yard in tip top shape, and hosting her annual family gathering every July.

Wilma is predeceased by her husband Frederick Phoebus; her sister, Rose Stevens; and brother, William Shaulis, Jr. She is survived by: her sisters, Sandra Shaulis, Ella Angstadt; nieces, Jamie Usilton, Wendy Sommers, Emily Fox, Wendy Lou Stevens; and nephews, William Shaulis III, Scott Stevens, Jimmy Wishart, Steve Stevens, Allen Stevens, and Dean Stevens.

A service will be held at Fellows, Helfenbein & Newnam Funeral home in Chester, MD, on Wednesday, August 10, 2022, at 11am with a visitation from 9am -11am.
