



## Wilma Edith Trippe

June 24, 1934 - July 25, 2014

Wilma E. Trippe, 80, of Easton, MD, died at the University of Maryland Shore Medical Center at Easton on July 25, 2014.

Born in Hendersonville, NC, on June 24, 1934, she was the daughter of the late Harvey S. Cantrell and Jennie Cooper Cantrell. She was a 1952 graduate of Etowah High School. She was a member of the Beulah Baptist Church in Big Willow, NC, until moving to Maryland. She made her home in Annapolis until moving to Easton in 1980, where she attended the First Baptist Church of Easton.

Mrs. Trippe is survived by her daughter; Diane Russell of Fairview, NC; two sons, Randall Ballard of Annapolis and Richard Ballard of Easton; two sisters, Mary Steadman of Zirconia, NC, and Dollie Fowler of Leesburg, FL; two brothers, Henry Cantrell of Zirconia, NC, and Johnnie Cantrell of Ingleside, MD; 14 grandchildren; 23 great-grandchildren; and seven great-great grandchildren.

She was preceded in death by her husband, Henry Vanderford Trippe, Jr., who died on September 28, 2013, and a son, Robert F. Ballard.
