Chester, MD: Wilma Spray of Chester, MD formerly of Mayo, MD passed on Friday, December 30, 2005 at her home of renal failure, after a long and courageous battle with liver disease as a result of Hepatitis C.

Born Wilma Jones in St. Clair, Missouri on June 12, 1927, she was the daughter of the late Ernest and Anna Jones.

Wilma moved from St. Clair to Washington, D.C. in 1945 to work for the War Department and attend Strayer Business College. It was there that she met and married her first husband John W. Hull. Their marriage ended in divorce and he died in 1988.

During her career, she worked for the Maryland Legislature and the U.S. Naval Experiment Station. She retired from Honeywell Inc, in Annapolis, after 30 years of service.

She married Elmer (Ray) Spray on June 11, 1977. He passed away in 1989.

Wilma was member of the First Baptist Church of Stevensville and the American Legion Auxiliary of Post 268. Before her illness forced her to give up many of her activities, she was a tennis player and avid golfer. She also enjoyed traveling and boating the Chesapeake Bay. Wilma loved making

quilts for her family. She was a devoted mother, grandmother and great grandmother and most of all enjoyed spending time with her family..

She is survived by her sister, Irene Rosch of St. Clair, Missouri and five children. Three sons, John (Jackie) Hull, and his wife Linda, Richard Hull and his wife Mary, Alan Hull and his wife Brenda, all of Edgewater and two daughters; Patricia (Patty) Veon and her husband Bob Wakenight of New Market and Sharon Volm of Centerville. Eleven grandchildren and five great grandchildren also survive her.
