Wilson A. Taylor of Sudlersville, MD died Monday, January 17, 2005 at Corsica Hills Assisted Living in Centreville, MD. He was 82.

Born on July 24, 1922 in Chestertown, MD, he was the son of the late, Wendell H. Taylor and Suzy B. Rollinson. He attended school in Chestertown and starting working on a farm. In 1939 he served in the Army in the 29th Division with the 115th Infantry during WW II and was honorably discharged in 1947. He returned to Chestertown and married Edith Morris Starkey.
