



## Winfield Oliver Stinchcomb

August 31, 1950 - June 1, 2008

Winfield Oliver Stinchcomb of Tilghman, MD, formerly of McDaniel, died at his home on Sunday, June 1, 2008. He was 57.

Born August 31, 1950 in Baltimore, MD, he was the son of Betty J. Stinchcomb of McDaniel, MD and the late Winfield H. Stinchcomb. At the age of three he moved to the Eastern Shore of Maryland with his family.
