



Winifred Harward Howell

April 3, 1918 - July 22, 2015

Winifred (Win) Howell, of Easton, MD, and formerly of Oxford, MD, died peacefully in her home on July 22, 2015.

Born in Philadelphia on April 3, 1918, Win was raised in Bel Air, MD. In 1939, she earned her BS degree from Western Maryland College and then taught Home Economics for two years at Aberdeen High School before working for a clothing designer in Baltimore. On July 17, 1942, Win married Edgar M. (Dixie) Howell.

The Howells lived in Falls Church for over twenty years before moving to Oxford, MD, in 1973, where Dixie died in 1983. Win was a Vestry member and Altar Guild member at The Church of the Holy Trinity in Oxford, and was a member of the Talbot Country Club, the Harbor Club, the Oxford Museum, the Talbot County Garden Club and the Tred Avon Yacht Club. Her hobby was gardening and flower arranging. In 2002, Win moved to Easton, where she continued gardening activities and became a leader among the residents at William Hill Manor.

Win is survived by two children, Harriet Custer and her husband, James, of Anacortes, WA, and Edgar M. (Pete) Howell, Jr., and his wife, Dee, of Roseville, CA, as well as her daughter-in-law, Katie Howell, of Alexandria, widow of Win's youngest son, Jarrett, who died on September 1, 2013. In

addition, Win is survived by her siblings, Barbara Baker of Aberdeen and Winfield (Baker) Harward, Jr., and his wife, Lois, of Bel Air. Win had four grandchildren, Paul and Anna Custer, William Taylor, and Bethany Pultz, as well as two great-grandchildren, Mac and Robert Lee Pultz.

A Memorial service will be held at The Church of the Holy Trinity, Oxford, on Thursday, July 30 at 1 p.m., followed by a reception and celebration of Win's life at Holy Trinity's Fellowship Hall.

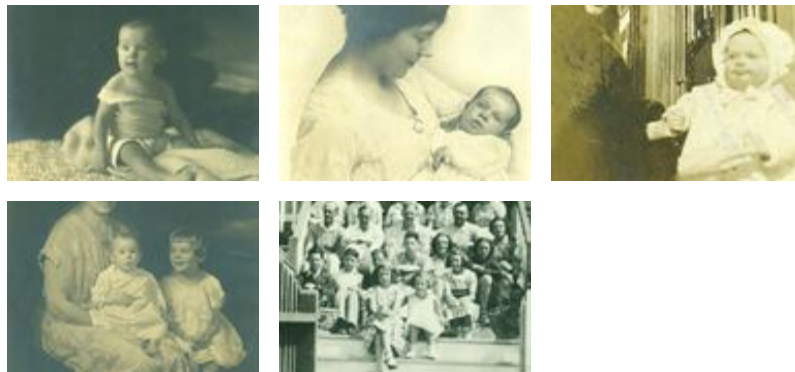
