Wm. Elmer "Pop" McLaughlin of Easton, MD died on Saturday, April 27, 2002 at Talbot Hospice House, Easton. He was 75.

Born August 27, 1926 in Kent County, MD he was the son of the late William H. and Emma E. Emory McLaughlin. After attending public school in Kent County, he served in the United States Army during the Korean Conflict. Following his release from active duty, he, in 1956, married the former Sadie M. Collins, They resided in Chestertown until moving to Talbot County in 1959. During his working years he was a carrier for the Washington Post, Baltimore Sun and most recently the Star Democrat. He also worked as a security guard at Black & Decker.

Mrs. McLaughlin died November 18, 1995.

His memberships included Easton Moose Lodge #1520, American Legion Post #18 in Centreville, and a life member of the Cordova Fire Dept.

Mr. McLaughlin is survived by five children, Connie Kurtz and her husband, Roger, Elizabeth Marie Cordes and her husband, Bob, Sandra K.
