Wylie Fay Leon Tuttle, Jr. of Rock Hall, MD, died on Friday, March 29, 2002 at his home. He was 79.

Born September 12, 1922 in New York, he was the son of the late Wylie Fay Leon Tuttle, Sr. and Florence "Merriman" Tuttle. Mr. Tuttle served in the United States Navy as a pilot and flew in the South Pacific during World War II. After the war he began his career as a Real Estate Developer. Throughout his career he was responsible for building the First National bank in both Mobile, Alabama as well as the First National Bank in Nashville, Tenn. He also built the Tour Maine-Montparnasse in Paris as well as five major buildings in Chicago. In the later part of his life he spent most of his time breeding and racing Thoroughbred horses on his farm the Rock Hall Stud as well as in France.

Wylie Tuttle is survived by his wife, Janet Tuttle of Rock Hall, MD; and his daughter, Amanda Tuttle of Rock Hall, MD.

Services will be held Monday, April 1, 2002, at 11 am at the Old St. Paul's Episcopal Church in Chestertown, MD.

Interment will follow services at the Old St. Paul's Cemetery in Chestertown, MD.
